DRESS CODE

Isabelle Sellon School aims to create and maintain a friendly and professional atmosphere that fosters a safe, secure and caring learning environment for all students and staff that will nurture personal growth and positive attitudes.

Students must be dressed appropriately at school. Appropriately dressed means:

- Respectful, age appropriate and allows full participation in all learning activities
- Outerwear must cover underwear and midriff (stomach and back)
- Messages printed on clothing are in good taste (alcohol/drug related, profanity and violent materials are not permitted)
- Headwear of any sort is not allowed in any classroom environment and must be kept in their locker

Students will be asked to change clothing if dress is not respectful or age appropriate. Parents will be notified if an issue persists.
