Our school wide, **Wildly Important Goal (WIG)** is to improve reading comprehension by 1 grade level over the course of the school year. Students are tracking their own reading progress and re-evaluating strategies to achieve their goals. Here's how we are progressing to date:

Average Grade Equivalency in Grade 4- 3.5(Sept.) to 3.8(Nov.) to 3.9(Feb.)
Average Grade Equivalency in Grade 5- 4.3(Sept.) to 5.1(Nov.) to 5.1(Feb.)
Average Grade Equivalency in Grade 6- 5.4(Sept.) to 5.7(Nov.) to 5.9(Feb.)

School wide strategies include targeted small reading groups as part of regular classroom instruction, accountability partners to ensure students and staff stay committed to their goals, a scoreboard to visibly track our progress, as well as celebrations along the way to acknowledge growth.

The **Crowsnest Pass Music Festival** is happening in the community from March 20th - March 31st and Isabelle Sellon School is participating. All students in grades 4-6 are all participating in at least one performance, with some students being involved in as many as four performances!
